		Asian Undergraduate Students selected to participate in this programme will develop a strong sense of cross-cultural intelligence, gain a network of friends and a better understanding of our nation.
		More than 50 Selected Asian Undergraduate Students will be offered to study a semester at NTU with tuition and living expenses covered.

Who is Eligible?	Open to nationals of member countries of ASEAN, China and India
	(except Singapore) to pursue a semester of coursework at NTU.
Requirements	• Applicants must be a full-time Undergraduate student in one of NTU exchange partner institutions.
	• Have completed 2 semesters of study at home university, with proof of results.
	• NTU will only review student applications that are nominated and formally submitted to NTU International Relations Office (IRO) by the exchange coordinators of exchange partner universities.
	• Each NTU partner institutions <b>should not submit more than five (5)</b> applications, unless otherwise indicated, for NTU's review.
	• Each nominee should be from different faculty/schools.
	<ul> <li>Applicants should possess the following:</li> <li>a) An excellent academic record - within the top 5% of cohort</li> <li>b) A very good command of the English Language</li> <li>c) Hold leadership positions in any of university student activity clubs</li> </ul>
	• Student to submit a 200-word letter on why he/she deserves to be part of the LEaRN programme. (Please list the leadership roles that student is currently undertaking, including any involvement in any form of Social Community Services.)
	• A Recommendation Letter from faculty of host institution and an outline of a CV of the nominee's accomplishments.
	• Students must take a minimum of two (2) courses and are not allowed to audit any subjects when here on the programme. They should also aim to do well in the courses chosen.
	• There is no bond attached to <b>LEaRN</b> .
